THE LESSON OF THE LEPER KING

Uzziah was a good king who--in the beginning of his reign--found his strength in the living God, and who God Himself had truly made strong. But the greatness of his prosperity turned into his downfall when it became mixed with pride. One day, he even dared to intrude into the ministry in the temple that God had given strictly to the priests--at great cost to himself.

As his story teaches, the danger of pride in God's calling for us is that it might move us to intrude arrogantly into His calling for others.
