# MAKING PLANS THAT HONOR THE MASTER

Theme: As the servants of Jesus Christ, we should make personal plans (see Proverbs 16:9; Psalm 37:23-24); but in such a way as to always honor to the sovereignty of our Master (see 1 Corinthians 16:13-14). We do this ...

- 1. BY KEEPING OUR OWN PLANS TENTATIVE (v. 5). (See 2 Corinthians 1:15-2:2.)
- 2. BY ALLOWING TIME FOR RELATIONSHIPS (v. 6-7a).
- 3. BY ALWAYS SAYING, 'IF THE LORD PERMITS' (v. 7b). (See James 4:13-17.)
- 4. BY WATCHING FOR 'OPEN DOORS' (vv. 8-9a). (See Acts 19:1-7.)
