FOR THE FURTHERANCE OF THE GOSPEL

Our God is sovereign over the circumstances of life (*see Ephesians 1:11; Romans 8:28-30; 1 Corinthians 10:13.*) As Paul's own experience in a Roman prison shows us; We should trust our sovereign Father to use our current circumstances to further the message of the gospel.

1. **GOD'S PART: He sovereignly works through our circumstances in life to spread the gospel of Christ (v. 12).**
(*See Acts 9:15-16.*)

2. **OUR PART: We should trust Him to use us in the circumstances ...**
 1. As faithful witnesses of Christ to those around us (v. 13).
(*See 2 Corinthians 2:14-17.*)
 2. As an encouragement others to speak confidently for Christ (v. 14).
(*See 2 Timothy 1:8-13.*)
 3. By rejoicing in however it may be that Christ is preached (vv. 15-18).
