HANDING OUR PLANS TO OUR LORD

Because we cannot know what tomorrow will bring, we must humbly submit our plans to our sovereign Lord.

- 1. IT'S ALRIGHT TO MAKE PLANS IN LIFE (v. 13).
- 2. BUT BECAUSE OF THE FRAILTIES OF LIFE, WE CANNOT KNOW WHAT TOMORROW MAY BRING (v. 14). (See Luke 12:16-21; Proverbs 27:1).
- 3. SO, AS BELIEVERS WE SHOULD ALWAY SUBMIT OUR PLANS TO OUR SOVEREIGN LORD (v. 15). (See Acts 18:21; 1 Corinthians 4:18-19; 16:5-7; Philippians 2:19; Hebrews 6:3).
- 4. TO REFUSE TO DO THIS IS SINFUL ARROGANCE (vv. 16-17).
