Scripture Reading: Mark 16:1-8 (NKJV)

16 When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus' body. ² Very early on the first day of the week, just after sunrise, they were on their way to the tomb ³ and they asked each other, "Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?"

⁴But when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been rolled away. ⁵ As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed.

Joy to the world, He is risen, Alleluia! He's risen, Alleluia! He's risen, Alleluia!



THE WITNESS FOR THE RESURRECTION

Theme: The testimony of the apostles shows us why we proclaim the resurrection of Jesus Christ to this world.

- 1. GOD RAISED HIM FROM THE DEATH OF THE CROSS (v. 30). (See Acts 2:23; Psalm 22, esp. v. 21b; Isaiah 53:10-11.)
- 2. HE HAS BEEN EXALTED AS PRINCE AND SAVIOR (v. 31). (See Romans 1:4; Acts 3:15; Hebrews 1:3.)
- 3. THE SPIRIT NOW BEARS WITNESS THROUGH THE CHURCH (v. 32). (See John 15:26-27.)
