Theme: Paul's words about the household of Stephanus (see 1 Corinthians 1:16), remind us that we should appreciate those who devote themselves to the well-being of their church family.

The household of Stephanus were ...

- First to believe.
- Devoted to the ministry of the saints
- Hard co-workers with Paul.
- Suppliers of what was needed.
- Encouragers to the soul.

Therefore, when it comes to such faithful servants, Paul said ...

1. **KNOW THEM (v. 15).**
2. **SUBMIT TO THEM (v. 16).**
3. **ACKNOWLEDGE THEM (vv. 17-18).**
