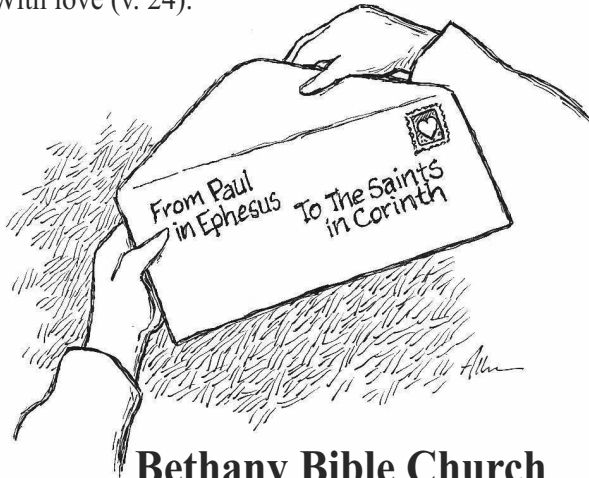
GREETINGS IN THE LORD

 - C. From the brethren at large (v. 20a).

2. **TO EACH OTHER IN THE CHURCH FAMILY (v. 20b).**

3. **FROM THE APOSTLE HIMSELF (vv. 21-24).**
 - A. With authenticity (v. 21).
 - B. With seriousness (v. 22).
 - C. With graciousness (v. 23).
 - D. With love (v. 24).
