Theme: We should grow in our reliance upon the indwelling Holy Spirit as our Helper in the Christian life.

1. JESUS PROMISED THAT, AS HIS FOLLOWERS, WE WOULD DO GREATER WORKS THAN HIM (John 14:12-14) ...

- Greater miraculous works
- Greater works of humble service
- The winning of more souls to His kingdom
- Answers to every prayer in His name even though He was going to leave them (16:6-7).


2. THIS WOULD BE BECAUSE HE WOULD SEND THE HOLY SPIRIT TO US IN HIS PLACE (John 14:15-16a).

- a. Apart from Jesus, we can do nothing (John 15:1-5).
- b. But Jesus sends us "another Helper" like Himself (John 14:15-16); who would be ...
 - our Teacher (John 14:25-26).
 - the One who bears witness with us (John 15:26-27).
 - the Convictor of the hearts of those around us (John 16:8-10).
 - our Counselor in times of need (John 16:12-13).
 - the Revealer of Jesus to us (John 16:14-15).

3. THUS, THE HOLY SPIRIT MINISTERS THE VERY PRESENCE OF JESUS TO US (John 14:16b-18).

This is why Jesus could say, "and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age" (Matthew 28:20).
