Theme: God comforts us in our trials so that we may share His comfort with each other. From this passage, we see that ...

1. **THE HEAVENLY FATHER IS ITS SOURCE (v. 3).**
See Micah 7:18.
2. **ITS PURPOSE IS THAT IT BE SHARED (v. 4).**
See Hebrews 2:17-18.
3. **IT'S SUFFICIENT FOR OUR SUFFERING (v. 5).**
See 2 Corinthians 4:7-10; 12:7-10.
4. **IT MAKES IT POSSIBLE TO MINISTER TO EACH OTHER (v. 6).**
See Philippians 4:9.
5. **WE CAN HAVE CONFIDENCE IN ITS WORK (v. 7).**
