This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the New Testament book of 2 Corinthians; and is taken from 2 Corinthians 1:12-14

A BOAST WORTH PROTECTING

We are to have a truly 'heavenly' view in life (Colossians 3:1-4; Philipians 3:20-21; 1 John 3:1-3; Titus 2:11-14). This heavenly view is to affect how we view each other in the body of Christ (1 Thessalonians 2:17-20).

As followers together of Jesus, and as ministers together in His Kingdom's cause, we should conduct ourselves with integrity in the present, because we will be one-another's cause for rejoicing in eternity ...

1. CONDUCTING OURSELVES WITH INTEGRITY (v. 12) ...

-- *With simplicity.*

-- *With godly sincerity.*

-- *Not in fleshly wisdom (see 1 Corinthians 2:1-5).*

-- *By the grace of God (see 1 Timothy 1:15-16; Revelation 7:9-10).*

2. SPEAKING WITH CONSISTENCY TO ONE ANOTHER (v. 13a).

(See Ephesians 4:25; 2 Corinthians 10:10.)

3. FOCUSING ON OUR MUTUAL JOY IN ETERNITY (vv. 13b-14).
