The description of the people of the kingdom – Matt. 5:1-10

Happy doesn't mean happy as we normally think happy, the beatitudes tell us what we are; not what we are to do. Eph, 2:10

The beatitudes are not some new morality Jesus is teaching. Isa. 57:15, Isa. 61, Psa.51, Psa. 37;11; Psa. 119:20

Do not be conformed to the ways of this world... Ro. 12:2; the beatitudes turn upside down the ways of the world; thus, those who walk in the character of kingdom citizens turn the world upside down Acts 17:6

The beatitudes are descriptions of Jesus Philippians 2 – poor in spirit, Matt. 11:28ff – meek, Heb. 10:9 - I come to do thy will etc.;

He is the vine, we are the branches; we are salt and light.
