Upward for aye on wings like a dove, Jesus, I come to Thee.

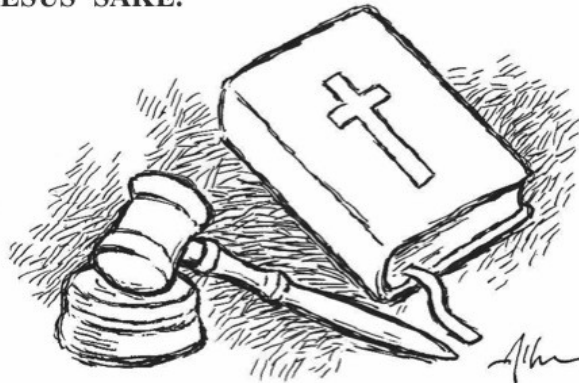
Out of the fear and dread of the tomb,

BOLD OBEDIENCE

Theme: The people of God must be faithful to God in the way that they obey God rather than man. As this passage shows us, when opposed in our faith by civil authority, we should ...

- 1. MAKE SURE THAT IT IS TRUE OPPOSITION TO THE FAITH.**
(See *Romans 12:17*.)
- 2. BE AS RESPECTFUL AS POSSIBLE TO HUMAN AUTHORITY.**
(See *Romans 13:1-4*.)
- 3. TURN OPPOSITION INTO AN OPPORTUNITY FOR WORSHIP.**
(See *Psalms 2:1-12*.)
- 4. PASS ALL THREATS OVER TO GOD.**
(See *Daniel 3:16-18; Luke 10:16*.)
- 5. PRAY FOR THE BOLDNESS TO KEEP ON PROCLAIMING JESUS.**
(See *Ephesians 6:19-20*.)
- 6. TRUST GOD TO VINDICATE HIS OWN WORD.**
(See *2 Timothy 2:8-9*.)
- 7. ALWAYS REJOICE WHEN CALLED UPON TO SUFFER FOR JESUS' SAKE.**
(See *Acts 5:40-42; 1 Peter 4:12-13*.)
