CHRIST'S LIVING EPISTLE

The Bible gives us many examples of 'letters of commendation' or of 'endorsement' (see Romans 16:1; Philippians 2:25-30; Colossians 4:7-9; 1 Corinthians 16:10-11; 2 Corinthians 8:23-24). As believers, we are a living epistle that commends the message of the gospel of Jesus Christ to the world.

As this passage shows us, we are ...

- 1. A SUPERIOR EPISTLE OF COMMENDATION (v. 1). (See Philippians 2:14-16.)
- 2. WRITTEN TO BE READ BY THE WORLD (v. 2.) (See 1 Thessalonians 1:7-10.)
- 3. BEARING A MARVELOUS ENDORSEMENT (v. 3). (See Jeremiah 31:31-34; 2 Corinthians 3:4-6.)
