
This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the New Testament book of 2 Corinthians; and is taken from 2 Corinthians 3:4-6

MADE SUFFICIENT

The greatest message the world has ever heard is the declaration of the new covenant--the gospel of Jesus Christ. Who, in themselves, is sufficient for such a message? Our sufficiency is from God (Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8). As Paul shows us, whoever God calls to proclaim the new covenant, He also makes sufficient for it.

Looking at these three verses (in reverse order), we can see ...

- THE LIFE-GIVING POWER OF THE NEW COVENANT (v. 6). (See Exodus 19:3-6; Jeremiah 31:31-34; Hebrews 9:13-15; John 3:16-17.)
- THE SUFFICIENCY OF ITS MINISTERS THROUGH GOD (v. 5). (See Galatians 1:11-12; 1 Timothy 1:12-17; Ephesians 3:8-13.)
- THE CONFIDENCE THAT COMES FROM THE SUFFICIENCY (v. 4). (See 2 Corinthians 3:1-3.)
