

This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the New Testament book of 2 Corinthians; and is taken from 2 Corinthians 3:7-11

MUCH MORE GLORIOUS

The old covenant—through the law of God—could not save (Romans 3:20). Instead, God saves through the new covenant by faith in Jesus (Romans 3:21-23). As Paul shows us in this passage, the ministry of the new covenant is much more glorious than the ministry of the old...

- AS THE SPIRIT IS THAN DEATH (vv. 7-8). (See Exodus 34:29-35; Romans 7:7-11; Romans 7:6.)
- AS RIGHTEOUSNESS IS THAN CONDEMNATION (v. 9). (See Romans 8: 1-4.)
- AS GREATER LIGHT IS THAN LESSER (v. 10). (See Matthew 17:1-8.)
- AS THAT WHICH REMAINS IS THAN THAT WHICH PASSES AWAY (v. 11). (See Hebrews 10:11-14.)
