This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the New Testament book of 2 Corinthians; and is taken from 2 Corinthians 4:1-6

TELLING IT PLAINLY

Our God has--from the beginning--ordained, "Let there be light" (Genesis 1:3). The gospel of Jesus is that light that now shines in the world (John 1:4-5). Paul preached this glorious gospel of the 'new covenant' (see vv. 12-18); and as his own example in this passage shows us, the nature of this gospel of Jesus motivates us to tell it plainly. We do so by ...

- 1. SPEAKING AS RECIPIENTS OF GOD'S MERCY (v. 1). (See 1 Timothy 1:12-16; 1 Corinthians 15:8-10.)
- 2. KEEPING AT IT EARNESTLY AND FAITHFULLY (v. 1b). (See 2 Corinthians 4:7-16.)
- 3. SETTING ASIDE ALL TRICKS OF PERSUASION (v. 2a). (See 2 Corinthians 2:17; 1 Corinthians 2:1-5.)
- 4. PROCLAIMING IT WITH CONFIDENT SINCERITY (v. 2b). (See 1 Thessalonians 2:5-12.)
- 5. KNOWING THAT NOT ALL WILL UNDERSTAND IT (vv. 3-4). (See John 12:39-40.)
- 6. PUTTING THE FOCUS UPON JESUS (v. 5). (See 1 Corinthians 3:5.)
- 7. TRUSTING THAT GOD WANTS IT TO BE KNOWN (v. 6).
