- 3. GOD IN LOVE SENT HIS SON JESUS
TO PAY THE DEBT FOR SIN ON THE CROSS.**
(See Romans 6:23b; Romans 5:8 Isaiah 53:6; 2 Corinthians 5:21.)
- 4. WE MUST PERSONALLY PLACE OUR FAITH
IN WHAT JESUS HAS DONE FOR US.**
(See John 3:16-17.)
