

UNWRAPPING THE GIFT OF RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is when a change is brought about in our relationship with God from enmity to peace. And <u>Christmas is the gift of reconciliation between</u> God and sinners.

As this passage shows us ...

- 1. IT'S A GIFT GIVEN BY JESUS' INCARNATION (v. 19). (See also Colossians 2:9-10; Luke 1:18-28; 2 Timothy 2:5.)
- 2. IT'S A GIFT MADE EFFECTUAL BY JESUS' CROSS (v. 20). (See also John 1:29; Romans 8:18-22.)
- 3. IT'S A GIFT THAT RESTORES US TO THE FATHER (vv. 21-22). (See Ephesians 4:17-19.)
- 4. IT'S A GIFT THAT IS OURS BY FAITH IN THE GOSPEL (vv. 23). (See 2 Corinthians 5:18-21.)
