This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the New Testament book of 2 Corinthians; and is taken from 2 Corinthians 13:5-6

EXAMINE YOURSELF!

It is dangerous to make assumptions--especially about our own salvation.

The Bible commands us to 'make our calling and election sure' (2 Peter 1:5-11); and urges us to present ourselves to God for His review of our hearts (Psalm 139:23-24).

In his words to a church that was troubled with divisiveness and sin, Paul reminds us that we must personally examine ourselves to make sure that we have a redeeming relationship with Jesus Christ. We must each ...

EXAMINE OUR BELIEF IN THE TRUTHS OF THE GOSPEL. (See 1 Corinthians 15:1-8; Romans 10:6-13.)

2. PUT OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS TO THE TEST.

(See John 15:5; Galatians 2:20; Colossians 1:27); which shows itself in ...

- -- A complete rest in God's favor by grace (Romans 8:16).
- -- A life of obedience to the Father's commands (John 15:10).
- -- A regular confession of and repentance from our sins (1 John 1:5-10).
- -- A love for our brothers and sisters in Christ (1 John 4:20).
- A desire to study the Bible (John 5:39).
- A habit of turning to the Father in times of trial (John 16:23-24).
- A readiness to forgive and show mercy to others (Matthew 18:21-35).
- A desire to bear witness of Him in this world (Acts 1:8).

MAKE SURE THAT WE STAND APPROVED BEFORE GOD.

Scripture Reading: 1 Corinthians 11:23-32, NKJV

For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."

For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.

Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks this cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the body and [c]blood of the Lord. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. For this reason many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep. For if we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged. But when we are judged, we are chastened by the Lord, that we may not be condemned with the world.
