THE ENRICHING POVERTY OF JESUS CHRIST

The Bible makes the amazing declaration that--in Christ--we are rich (Revelation 2:9). This was brought about for us by Jesus; and as this passage shows us, the self-sacrificial giving of Jesus motivates us to give of ourselves for one another.

Notice that ...

- 1. JESUS BECAME POOR TO MAKE US RICH (v. 9). (See John 17:5; Philippians 2:5-8; 1 Peter 1:3-5.)
- 2. WE NOW ABOUND IN THE RICHES OF HIS GRACE (v. 7). (See 1 Corinthians 1:4-7; 3:21-23; Ephesians 1:3; Colossians 2:9-10; 2 Peter 1:2-4.)
- 3. THEREFORE, WE HAVE THE INWARD MOTIVATION TO GIVE (v. 8).

(See 2 Corinthians 9:5-7; 8:3.)
