## UNDER THE BLOOD

Exodus 12:1-13 tells us of how--in judgment of Egypt--God 'passed over' the Jewish homes where the doorposts were painted with the blood of the passover lamb. In John 1:29, Jesus is identified to all as "the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world". And now, it is declared to us that we are made righteous in God's sight only by faith in the blood of Jesus.

Romans 3:21-26 tells us about this righteousness from God in terms of ...

1. **THE REVELATION OF IT (vv. 21-22a).**  
*(See Genesis 3:21; Psalm 51:2,7; Isaiah 53:5).*
2. **THE BENEFICIARIES OF IT (vv. 22b-23).**  
*(See Habakkuk 2:4; Genesis 15:6).*
3. **THE MEANS OF IT (vv.24-25a).**  
*(See Ephesians 1:7).*
4. **THE RESULT OF IT (vv. 25b-26).**

**Conclusion:**  
***Make sure that  
you're safe under  
the blood of Jesus!***

***(Romans 5:6-11).***
