This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the New Testament book of 2 Corinthians; and is taken from 2 Corinthians 8:10-15

PARTNERS IN GOD'S PROVIDENCE

The larger principle that underlies this passage is the providence of God (see 2 Corinthians 9:12-15). In these words we see that, when we give generously to meet the specific needs of God's people, we become partners with Him in His providential care for them.

Note from this passage that ...

- IT'S GOOD TO HAVE THE DESIRE TO GIVE (v. 10). (See also 2 Corinthians 8:6-7; 9:7; 8:1-5.)
- BUT ONLY IF IT'S PUT INTO ACTION AS WE ARE ABLE (v. 11). (See also 2 Corinthians 9:1-5.)
- GOD GIVES US THE MEANS TO FULFILL THAT DESIRE (v. 12). (See also 2 Corinthians 9:8-11.)
- THIS IS HIS DESIGN FOR OUR MUTUAL CARE (vv. 13-14). (See also Acts 2:42-47; 4:32-35.)
- THUS WE BECOME PARTNERS IN HIS PROVIDENCE TO EACH OTHER (v. 15).
