# THE GODLY WORK OF FOLLOW-THROUGH

Throughout the Bible, we find a quality exhibited in God's most faithful workers: they brought their willingness to serve into a completion of action (see Exodus 40:33; 1 Kings 6:14; Nehemiah 6:15-16; Acts 14:26; John 17:4; 19:30). As Paul's words to the Corinthian believers show us, a ready willingness to minister in Jesus' service is only good if it is followed-up with faithful completion.

From this passage, we see that ...

- A READY WILLINGNESS IN MINISTRY IS A GOOD THING TO HAVE (vv. 1-2).
- BUT IT MUST BE COMPLETED THROUGH FAITHFUL ACTION (vv. 3-4).

(See v. 2; 2 Timothy 1:6; Hebrews 10:24.)

 THEREFORE, WE OUGHT ALWAYS STRIVE TO BRING OUR GOOD INTENTION TO COMPLETION (v. 5). (See v. 7.)
