This morning's message is part of our ongoing study from the New Testament book of 2 Corinthians, and is taken from 2 Corinthians 9:6-9

GIVING FROM GOD'S GRACIOUS SUPPLY

The Bible teaches us to trust in the providential care of our heavenly Father (Matthew 6:19-21, 25-34; Malachi 3:10-12). This trust should also show itself in the way that we understand 'giving'. As Paul's words to the Corinthians show us, trusting completely in God's gracious provision will change the way that we give to others.

1. WE'LL GIVE <u>ABUNDANTLY</u>, BECAUSE 'GIVING' REALLY MEANS 'SOWING' (v. 6).

(See also Galatians 6:7-10; Luke 6:38.)

2. WE'LL GIVE <u>GLADLY</u>, BECAUSE OUR SUPPLIER LOVES A CHEERFUL GIVER (v. 7).

(See also Romans 15:25-27; 2 Corinthians 8:1-5.)

3. WE'LL GIVE <u>CONFIDENTLY</u>, BECAUSE GOD IS ABLE TO PROVIDE FOR EVERY GOOD WORK (vv. 8-9).

(See also Psalm 112; 2 Corinthians 9:10-15.)
