SETTING OUR HEARTS TOWARD USING OUR GIFTS

Now that we're back together again, it's a good time to think about the spiritual gifts. Those are special endowments that the Holy Spirit gives to each individual believer—just as He chooses—that empower them to fulfill their ministry to the church family (1 Corinthians 12:4-7).

This passage reminds us that we need to set our hearts once again toward using our gifts to serve the body of Christ. This means that ...

1. **WE NEED TO THINK OF OURSELVES AS INTERDEPENDENT** (v. 3).
(See Romans 1:11-12; Galatians 6:1-5; John 13:34-35.)
2. **WE NEED TO KEEP CONNECTED AS A BODY** (vv. 4-5).
(See 1 Corinthians 12:12-26.)
3. **WE NEED TO PUT OUR GIFTS TO WORK FOR EACH OTHER** (vv. 6-8).
(See Ephesians 4:11-16.)
