This morning's message is part of our ongoing study from the New Testament book of 2 Corinthians; and is taken from 2 Corinthians 10:1-6

MIGHTY IN GOD

The apostle Paul presented himself as unimpressive and lowly (1 Corinthians 2:1-5). For that reason, his opponents accused of making himself seem bold from a distance, but of being weak and lowly in actual presence (2 Corinthians 10:10). But they were only viewing him in fleshly terms. In this passage, he shows us that, as followers of Jesus, the weapons of our warfare are spiritual--and are therefore mighty in God.

- 1. WE MAY APPEAR IN THIS WORLD TO BE WEAK IN FLESHLY TERMS (v. 1). (See 1 Corinthians 4:9-13.)
- 2. BUT WE DO NOT OPERATE IN THIS WORLD BY FLESHLY MEANS (vv. 2-3). (See 2 Corinthians 4:7-15.)
- 3. FOR THE WEAPONS OF OUR WARFARE ARE MIGHTY IN GOD (vv. 4-6). (See Ephesians 6:10-20; Jeremiah 1:9-10.)
