OUR BETTER HIGH PRIEST

In the Old Testament, we are told about the ministry of the earthly tabernacle (Hebrews 9:1-5). But its ministry was limited and could not provide for us a full redemption (vv. 6-10). "But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come (v. 11); "entering the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption" (v. 12).

As this passage shows us, Jesus Christ—our crucified Savior—serves us as our better High Priest ...

- 1. HAVING ENTERED INTO A BETTER TABERNACLE (v. 11). (See Exodus 25:9; Hebrews 9:23-24.)
- 2. BEARING A BETTER OFFERING (vv. 12-14). (Leviticus 16; Numbers 19; Hebrews 10:1-10.)
- 3. AS MEDIATOR OF A BETTER COVENANT (v. 15). (Leviticus 18:4-5; Jeremiah 31:31-34; Hebrews 8:6.)
