

# OUR VALUE IN THE INVALUABLE CHRIST

The writer of Hebrews tells us that Jesus endured the cross “for the joy that was set before Him” (Hebrews 12:2). That joy was the prospect of us--with Him in heavenly glory--forever! Knowing the high price God paid for us should motivate us to live with reverent devotion.

As this passage shows us ...

1. **IF WE CALL UPON GOD AS OUR FATHER (v. 17a) ...**  
*(See 1 Peter 1:3; John 1:12-13; 1 Peter 1:14-15)*
2. **THEN WE SHOULD LIVE BEFORE HIM WITH REVERENT DEVOTION (v. 17b) ...**  
*(See 1 Peter 1:7, 9-12)*
3. **KNOWING THE HIGH PRICE THAT WAS PAID FOR OUR REDEMPTION ...**
  - a. **In terms of its purity (vv. 18-19).**  
*(See Revelation 1:5-6)*
  - b. **In terms of its eternity (v. 20).**  
*(See Revelation 13:8)*
  - c. **In terms of its security (v. 21).**  
*(See Romans 4:25)*

**Conclusion:**  
Let's truly know the price  
that Jesus paid for us ...  
and live accordingly!
