MAKING OUR BOAST IN THE CROSS

It may seem strange that Paul would boast in a 'cross'. A cross was a despised thing. But Paul didn't boast in just 'any' cross. He boasted in the cross of Jesus--where in great humility (Philippians 2:6-9), the Son of God "despised the shame" (Hebrews 12:2) to redeem us. No wonder Paul made it his 'boast'!

This passage shows us that when we make our boast in the cross of Jesus, certain things fall into place ...

 THIS WORLD'S EVALUATION WILL CEASE TO HAVE ANY HOLD UPON US (v. 14).

(See 1 John 2:15-17; Philippians 3:7-11.)

 BEING A 'NEW CREATION' WILL BE ALL THAT MATTERS (v. 15). (See Romans 6:4-6; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Galatians 2:20.)

 GENUINE PEACE AND MERCY FROM GOD THEN BECOME OURS (v. 16).

(See Galatians 3:29; Romans 2:28-29.)

Question: Have you made sure that the cross of Jesus is your only boast before God?
