This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the New Testament book of 2 Corinthians; and is taken from 2 Corinthians 12:1-6

'I KNOW A MAN'

Paul had a remarkable experience. He had been given a glimpse of heavenly glory. It clearly had an impact on him, and greatly motivated him in ministry (see Philippians 1:19-23; 3:7-11; 2 Corinthians 4:16-18; 5:1-4). But how he carefully described it to the Corinthians teaches us that even when it comes to remarkable spiritual experiences, we must take the attention off ourselves and keep it on Christ.

Paul's example, in the light of his own remarkable experience, teaches us to ...

- SEEK ONLY WHAT IS PROFITABLE TO OTHERS (v. 1). (See Colossians 2:18-19.)
- KEEP ONLY TO THE BASIC FACTS (vv. 2-4). (See Luke 23:43; Revelation 2:7.)
- PLACE THE ATTENTION ON THE GOSPEL (vv. 5-6). (See 2 Corinthians 12:7-10.)
