This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the New Testament book of 2 Corinthians; and is taken from 2 Corinthians 12:11-19

## SEEKING NOT 'YOURS' BUT 'YOU'

Theme: Jesus' love is a sacrificial love that seeks our whole-hearted devotion to Him. Paul sought to communicate this to the Corinthians through what feels like a 'parental lecture'. He was motivated to do this because he had 'betrothed them' to Christ (11:1-2), and was very concerned that they stay true to Him.

In this passage, we see how Paul illustrated Jesus' love to the Corinthian believers in that ...

**1. IT GRIEVED HIM THAT HE HAD TO CONVINCe THEM OF HIS DEVOTION TO THEM.** It was as if he said:

- A. "Shame on you for not standing up for me when others were discrediting me!" (vv. 11-12; see also 1 Corinthians 15:9-10; Romans 15:18-19.)
- B. "Shame on you for thinking that you were somehow 'missing out' because of me!" (v. 13; see also 1 Corinthians 9:16-18.)
- C. "Shame on you for not appreciating the sacrifices I have made for you!" (vv. 14-15; see also Romans 9:1-3.)
- D. "Shame on you for believing the worst about me!" (vv. 16-18.)

**2. BUT HE DID WHAT HE DID FOR THEM BECAUSE HE SOUGHT THEIR DEVOTION TO JESUS**  
(v. 19; see also 1 Corinthians 4:3-4.)

**3. THIS REMINDS US OF HOW WE SHOULD RESPOND TO JESUS' OWN LOVE FOR US**  
(See Romans 12:1-2.)
