UNITED UNTO HOLINESS

False teachers had made their way into the Corinthian church, and were sowing disunity among the Christians. That divisiveness was creating a breeding-ground in which immorality was growing. Paul spoke to that disunity directly. What he wrote teaches us that we must work together with unity in Christ so that we can protect the holiness of the church.

1. **OUR EDIFICATION IN CHRIST IS WHAT WE SEEK (v. 19).**
(See 2 Corinthians 13:7; 2:17; 13:9; Ephesians 4:11-16.)
2. **OUR UNITY IN CHRIST IS WHAT IS ESSENTIAL (v. 20).**
(See Philippians 2:1-4.)
3. **OUR HOLINESS IN CHRIST IS WHAT WE PROTECT (v. 21).**
(See Matthew 18:15-20.)
