'DO NOT WORRY ABOUT TOMORROW'

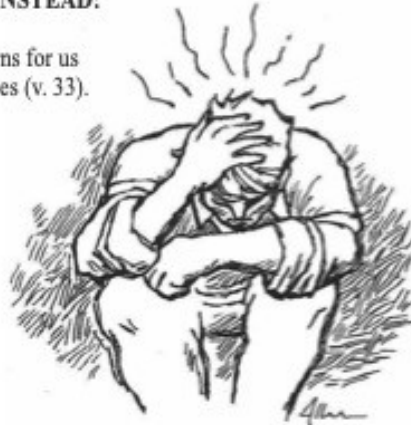
Theme: The Lord Jesus' instruction teaches us not to be excessively concerned about the daily provisions for our life in the coming year.

1. WHY WE SHOULDN'T WORRY (vv. 25-32):

- a. Our Lord and Master commands us to stop it (vv. 25, 31, 34).
- b. We're worth more to Him than the things that we worry about (v. 25).
- c. Our Father has already proven to be a good Provider (vv. 26, 28-30).
- d. Worry is a complete waste of time and energy (v. 27).
- e. Worry is contrary to true faith in our Father (vv. 32-32).

2. WHAT WE SHOULD DO INSTEAD:

- a. Make our Father's concerns for us the first priority in our lives (v. 33).
- b. With our Father's help, refuse to bear any of tomorrow's burdens today (v. 34).
