LOVE'S TRUE PREFERENCES

The apostle Paul had to deal with some hard matters with the Corinthians. But how he did so exhibited a set of Christ-like 'preferences'. His example shows us that, if we love one another in Christ as we should, there will be certain things that we would prefer for each other; such as ...

1. HONORABLE BEHAVIOR OVER OUR REPUTATION (v. 7).
2. THE WORK OF TRUTH OVER OUR COMFORT (v. 8).
3. COMPLETENESS IN CHRIST OVER STRENGTH OF SELF (v. 9).
4. EDIFICATION OVER OUR POWER TO HARM (v. 10).

Congregational Scripture Reading: Philippians 2:1-11, NKJV

(Leader reads the italicized text; Congregation reads the boldfaced text)

Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
