A STUPID MAN'S WISDOM

Agur. Ever heard of him? No? Well; he was the self-proclaimed 'stupid' man of the Bible. But he's much more than that. He's living proof of what it says in Proverbs 1:7; that "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge" His example teaches us that, if we genuinely seek wisdom with a humble heart, we'll ultimately be led to God's revelation of Himself through His Son. He shows us the route to true wisdom; that ...

- WE MUST BEGIN WITH HUMILITY BEFORE GOD (vv. 1-3). (See Isaiah 5:20-21.)
- WE MUST LOOK WONDERINGLY AT GOD'S WORKS (v. 4). (See John 3:13; Romans 1:19-20.)
- WE'LL THEN BE LED TO GOD'S SELF-REVELATION (vv. 5-6). (See John 1:1-5, 14, 18.)
