The words of Agur--a man that God used to show us the path to true wisdom--teach us something important about the word of God itself. He declares to us that God's word is refined--tested and proven faultless. And the purity of God's word means that it must be trusted as God's complete provision for us.

In these two verses, Agur shows us ...

- 1. WHAT GOD'S WORD IS TO US.**
"Every word of God is pure ..."
(See also 2 Timothy 3:16-17.)
- 2. WHAT THIS MEANS FOR US.**
"He is a shield to those who put their trust in Him."
(See also Psalm 5:11-12; 18:30.)
- 3. WHAT WE SHOULD NEVER DO.**
"Do not add to His words ..."
(See Psalm 12, esp. vv. 6-7; Deuteronomy 4:1-2; Revelation 22:18-19.)
- 4. WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IF WE DID.**
"Lest He rebuke you, and you be found a liar."
(See Matthew 12:34-37.)
