
# 'THERE IS A GENERATION'

Theme: There is a 'generation'--a prevailing attitude of rebellious unbelief--from which we must keep ourselves distinct. It's found at any time in history (see Deuteronomy 32:5, 20; Matthew 17:17).

Agur spoke of it as having four characteristics:

- 1. **REJECTION OF AUTHORITY (v. 11).** (See Exodus 20:12; Proverbs 19:26; 20:20; 30:17.)
- **2. BLIND SELF-RIGHTEOUSNESS (v. 12).** (See Proverbs 3:7; 12:15; 16:2; Luke 11:39-44; Revelation 3:17.)
- 3. ARROGANT PRIDEFULNESS (v. 13). (See Proverbs 6:16-19; 21:4; Luke 18:9-14.)
- **4. INHUMANE GREEDINESS (v. 14).** (See Psalm 14:4-6; Micah 3:1-3; Matthew 23:14.)

# Congregational Scripture Reading: 1 Thessalonians 5:1-11, NKJV

(Leader reads the italicized text; congregation reads the boldfaced text)

But concerning the times and the seasons, brethren, you have no need that I should write to you. For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night.

For when they say, "Peace and safety!" then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains upon a pregnant woman. And they shall not escape.

But you, brethren, are not in darkness, so that this Day should overtake you as a thief. You are all sons of light and sons of the day. We are not of the night nor of darkness.

Therefore let us not sleep, as others do, but let us watch and be sober. For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk are drunk at night. But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation. For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, that whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with Him.

Therefore comfort each other and edify one another, just as you also are doing.
