FUTURE GLORY--PRESENT HOPE


Are you going through a time of suffering? The apostle Paul could relate (see 2 Corinthians 11:23-29). Yet, he had victorious joy in his trials. His example teaches us that <u>our confident expectation of future glory sustains us with hope during present trials</u>.

As this passage shows us, we have victory in trials as we--like Paul ...

1. LOOK AHEAD TO THE GLORIOUS REVEALING (vv. 18-19)

(See also Romans 8:16-17; 1 Thessalonians 4:15-17; 2 Corinthians 4:16-18; Colossians 3:1-4.)

- 2. LISTEN TO THE SOUND OF CREATION'S GROANING (vv. 20-23). (See also Genesis 3:17-19; Isaiah 65:17-19; Revelation 22:3-5.)
- 3. LEAN-IN TO THE PATIENCE OF WAITING (vv. 24-25). (See also 1 Peter 1:3-9; Isaiah 40:27-31.)
