THE WISE WOMAN OF TEKOA

As the story of the wise woman of Tekoa teaches us, we behave like the heavenly Father when we seek to end estrangement and restore broken relationships (see Matthew 5:21-26). We do this as we ...

1. **RECOGNIZE THAT ESTRANGEMENT HURTS**
(vv. 1-8; *see also Hebrews 12:15*).
2. **PURSUE RECONCILIATION WITH PERSISTENCE**
(vv. 9-11).
3. **POINT TO OUR FATHER AS THE EXAMPLE**
(vv. 12-17; *see also 2 Corinthians 5:18-19*).
4. **ENCOURAGE THOSE WHO SEEK TO RECONCILE**
(vv. 18-22).
5. **REMEMBER THAT RECONCILIATION TAKES TIME**
(vv. 23-24).
