
June 19, 2022 This morning's Father's Day message is taken from Genesis 12:1-3

THE FATHER OF BLESSING

God called a man named Abram from out of a world of paganism (Joshua 24:2; Acts 7:2; Genesis 31:53) in order to make him the father of a great nation-the nation of Israel. With trust in God's promise, Abram (later named Abraham) left everything behind and went at God's command. As a result, God made him the father of the Jewish people; and through him gave us the Redeemer of humankind.

Abraham teaches us that a godly father blesses his offspring through a faithful and obedient trust in the promises of the heavenly Father. In his story, we see ...

- 1. THE CALL FOR SEPARATION (v. 1). (See also Philippians 2:5-8; 3:7-8.)
- 2. THE PROMISE OF BLESSING (v. 2). (See also Matthew 19:29.)
- 3. THE RESULT FOR HUMANITY (v. 3). (See also Romans 5:20; Genesis 22:16-18.)

Congregational Scripture Reading: Romans 4:13-16 (NKJV)

For the promise that he would be the heir of the world was not to Abraham or to his seed through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.
