
KEEPING HOLD OF GOSPEL CONFIDENCE

The writer of Hebrews sought to encourage persecuted Christians to keep hold of their confidence in salvation through the cross of Jesus (see Hebrews 10:19-34). Such bold confidence is a great theme in the Book of Hebrews; and is something that's vital to fruitful Christian living (see Hebrews 3:6; 4:16; 10:19).

As believers today, we are under great pressure to cast that confidence aside. But as this passage teaches us, we must keep hold of our confidence before God through the cross, because Jesus is coming soon. In this passage, we see ...

- 1. WHAT IT IS THAT WE MUST KEEP (v. 35). (See Acts 4:8-12, 19-20.)
- 2. WHAT WE NEED IN ORDER TO KEEP IT (v. 36). (See Luke 21:19.)
- 3. WHAT MOTIVATES US TO KEEP IT (v. 37). (See Habakkuk 2:3; Acts 1:11; 2 Corinthians 4:17.)
- 4. WHAT THE RESULTS ARE FOR KEEPING IT (v. 38). (See Habakkuk 2:4.)
- 5. WHAT WE ARE WITH REGARD TO IT (v. 39).
