In the Old Testament book of Joshua, the people of Israel were told to enter the promise land, and take possession of their rich inheritance from God. Paul's wonderful epistle to the Ephesians gives us, as believers, a similar call.

In the introductory greeting of the letter, Paul teaches us that because God has given us every spiritual blessing in Christ--we're invited to thank Him and take possession of them. In these introductory words, we see ...

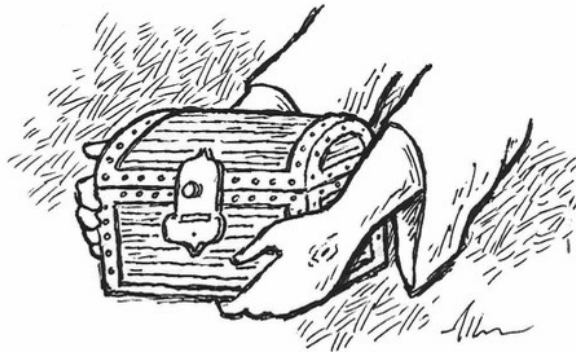
1. **THE AUTHOR (v. 1a).**

  - *Redemption (v. 7).*
  - *Revelation (vv. 8-10).*
  - *Inheritance (v. 11).*
  - *Sealing (v. 13).*
  - *Glorification (v. 14).*
