This morning's message is part of our ongoing series from the New Testament epistle to the Ephesians; and is taken from Ephesians 1:4-6

CHOSEN IN LOVE

In Ephesians 1:3, we're told that God has blessed the believer with "every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ". And in this morning's passage, we're shown the blessings we have in Christ from the heavenly Father.

Among the things that every human being needs are genuine value, significance and belonging. And in verses 4-6, Paul shows us that we who are in Jesus through faith have been given infinite value, significance and belonging by the heavenly Father.

1. WE HAVE INFINITE VALUE BECAUSE HE CHOSE US BEFORE CREATION IN CHRIST (v. 4).

(See Romans 8:28-30; 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14; 1 Peter 1:1-2; Acts 13:48).

- 2. WE HAVE INFINITE SIGNIFICANCE BECAUSE HE WILLINGLY ADOPTED US THROUGH CHRIST (v. 5). (See John 1:12-13; 20:17).
- 3. WE HAVE INFINITE BELONGING BECAUSE HE NOW ALWAYS WELCOMES US IN CHRIST (v. 6). (See John 3:16-17; 16:25-27; 17:20-23).
