This morning's message is part of our ongoing series from the New Testament epistle to the Ephesians; and is taken from Ephesians 1:7-8

REDEMPTION--FULL & FREE

"Redemption" basically means that a ransom price was paid to set someone competely free. The apostle Paul was himself once a slave to sin (2 Timothy 1:12-16). But Jesus paid the ransom price for freedom from sin with His blood (Mark 10:45). And in Ephesians 1:7-8, the apostle Paul tells us about how God has provided full redemption for us through the blood of His Son Jesus Christ.

In this passage, we see ...

1. WHAT GOD HAS GIVEN US IN CHRIST.

"In Him we have redemption" (see Romans 3:23-25).

2. HOW GOD HAS PROVIDED IT FOR US.

"through His blood" (see 1 Peter 1:17-19).

3. WHAT IT MEANS TO US PERSONALLY.


"the forgiveness of sins" (see Romans 6:15-18).

4. HOW GREAT THE MEASURE OF IT IS.

"according to the riches of His grace" (see Romans 5:20).

5. WHY WE CAN REST CONFIDENTLY IN IT.

"which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence" (see Ephesians 3:10-12).
