This morning's message is part of our ongoing study from the New Testament book of Ephesians; and is taken from Ephesians 1:9-10

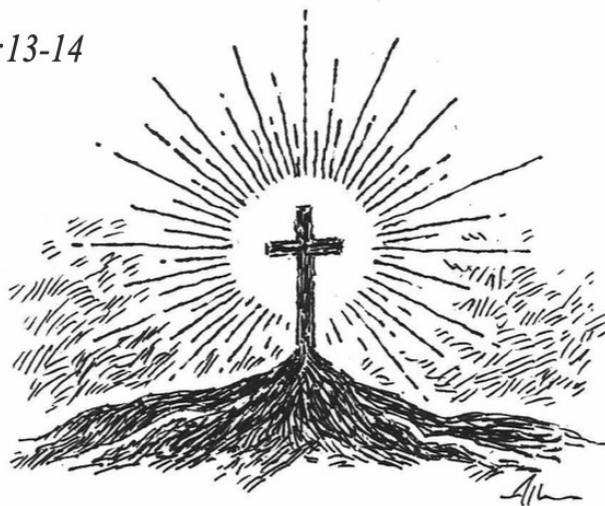
ALL THINGS IN CHRIST

Have you ever wondered, "What is this world coming to?" (see Ecclesiastes 1:2-11). Well; among the blessings that God gives us in Christ is the revelation of the answer to that question. As Paul lets us know in this morning's passage, it's the Father's plan--in the fullness of the times--to gather all things in one in Christ.

The Bible tells us about this plan in many other places (see Ephesians 1:21-23; Colossians 1:18-20; Philippians 2:9-11; 1 Corinthians 15:24-28). As this morning's passage shows us ...

1. **IT'S A MYSTERY THAT IS NOW MADE KNOWN TO US.**
(See Ephesians 3:3-5; Matthew 13:11-13, 16-17; John 15:15.)
2. **IT'S THE EXPRESSION OF THE FATHER'S OWN WILL.**
(See Romans 8:18-21.)
3. **IT'S THE CULMINATING EVENT OF ALL HISTORY.**
(See Genesis 3:15.)
4. **IT BRINGS TOGETHER ALL THINGS IN CHRIST TO THE GLORY OF THE FATHER.**
(See Ephesians 1:6, 12, 14).
