Intro

Living life with a clear vision of God's purpose in Christ. God will in the fullness of time will “gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth – in Him (Eph. 1:10 NKJV).”

God gives us a clear vision for being insightfully involved – activists for life. We want to encourage us to be insightfully involved through life's journey.

 - Igniting life in the Spirit

“23 Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. 24 He who calls you is faithful, who also will do it”

God's calls us to be insightfully involved in view of being united in God's purposes in Christ Jesus
