WE HAVE OBTAINED AN INHERITANCE'

There may be times that--in this world's eyes--we are quite poor. But the Lord Jesus has declared that, in reality, we are rich (Revelation 2:9). <u>Because of our relationship with the Son of God by faith, we have obtained a share in His own rich inheritance in glory.</u>

- 1. THE NATURE OF OUR INHERITANCE (v. 11a). (See John 17:4-5, 22, 24; Romans 8:16-17; 1 Peter 1:3-9.)
- 2. OUR SECURITY IN THIS INHERITANCE (v. 11b). (See Ephesians 1:4; Romans 8:28-30; Jude 24-25.)
- 3. THE REASON WE WERE GIVEN THIS INHERITANCE (v. 12b). (See Ephesians 3:8-11.)
- 4. WHO MAY HAVE A SHARE IN THIS INHERITANCE (v. 12a). (See Ephesians 2:8-9.)
