HIS INHERITANCE IN THE SAINTS

Everyone needs a sense of value--to know that they are important; that they have dignity; that they ultimately matter. But we cannot give value to ourselves. Instead, Ephesians 1:18 shows us that a godly sense of worth comes from knowing the Father's inheritance in the saints through Jesus Christ.
