'HIS POWER TOWARD US WHO BELIEVE'


There are many challenges in life; and many people fear that they don't have the strength to cope with them. Yet, the apostle Paul--who kept his eyes on Christ--manifested a strength from God that made him endure victoriously through every kind of trial (2 Corinthians 12:7-10; Philippians 4:10-13). His prayer for his believing friends was that they too would know about this power.

His words in Ephesians 1:19-23 show us that <u>confidence for living comes</u> through knowing the greatness of God's power toward those who believe.

- 1. THE BENEFICIARIES OF THIS POWER (v. 19). (See Ephesians 1:15-16; 3:20-21).
- 2. THE SUFFICIENCY OF THIS POWER (v. 19-20). (See 2 Corinthians 4:7-14).
- 3. THE DEMONSTRATION OF THIS POWER (vv. 20-23) ...
 - a. In Jesus' resurrection from the dead (see Romans 8:11).

b. In Jesus' enthronement to God's right hand (see Psalm 110:1; Hebrews 1:1-3).

- c. In Jesus' exaltation over all authority (See Philippians 2:9-11).
- d. In Jesus' supremacy over all creation (See Colossians 1:15-20).
- e. In Jesus' union with His church (See Ephesians 5:22-31).
