
This morning's message is part of our ongoing study of the Book of Daniel; and is taken from Daniel 2:1-49

A DREAM FROM THE GOD OF ALL TIMES AND SEASONS

God chose to give a dream to the ruler of the ruling world empire. It could be considered the most remarkable dream ever dreamed by a man; because in it, God revealed His plan from the Gentile nations—from that king's reign 600 years before our Lord's birth, all the way to the time of the Lord's second coming (Luke 21:24). And God revealed the meaning of this dream to Daniel.

In this dream, it's affirmed to us that the God of heaven completely rules over the times and seasons of human history. This is shown in the story of ...
